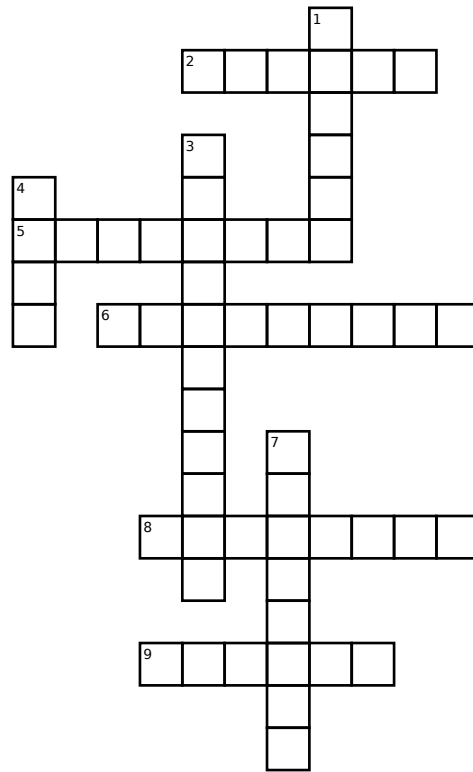


Vegetables
