- 1. Jane Austen is loved mainly as a guide to fashionable life in the **<u>Regency</u>** period, but her own vision of her task was radically different.
- 2. She was an ambitious and **<u>stern</u>** moralist.
- Born in <u>1775</u>, Austen grew up in a small village in Hampshire, where her father was the Anglican <u>rector</u>.
- 4. She did much of her writing at a **<u>tiny</u>** octagonal table.
- 5. The **novel** was her chosen weapon in the struggle to reform humanity.
- 6. **Darcy** starts of feeling superior because he has more money and higher status.
- 7. The story **rewards** them because they have developed well.
